Dear SMPS Members:

The Washington, DC Chapter is looking for **five members (including two alternates)** to serve on the 2008-2009 Board of Directors. I currently serve as President-Elect of the DC Chapter and Marketing Manager at Gilbane Building Company. During the 2008-2009 Program year, I will lead the Board of Directors as Chapter President.

As an SMPS board member, you will be required to head one of our programs or function areas.
